

Requirements

- A valid *stine ID / user ID* and your *password*.
- Access to the *internet* (e.g. via mobile network or private wi-fi network).
- Stay within the signal radius of the “eduroam” Wi-fi Network.

If you do not have a valid user ID or do not remember your password, please contact the ServiceDesk service team at the Regional Computing Center (RRZ).

1.

- If you have already configured eduroam, delete the saved configuration:

Settings -> Network -> Remove eduroam

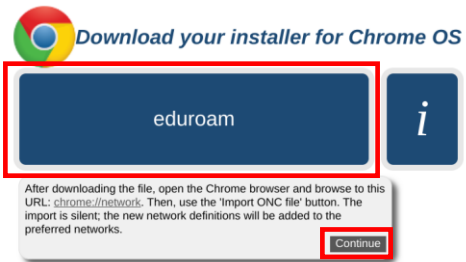
- Connect your Chrome-Book to internet.
e.g. via mobile network or private wi-fi network

2.

- Click the button below or type the URL into the Chrome browser.

- Click on “eduroam” button and on “Continue”.



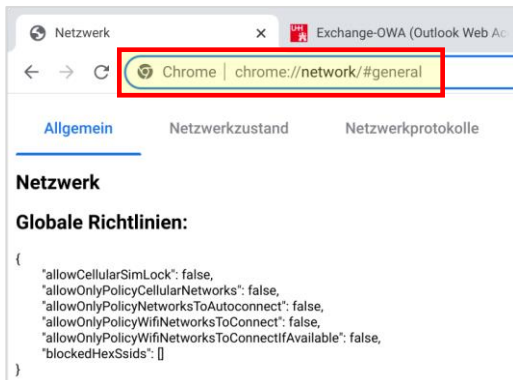
- Profile download starts automatically.

Open the Chrome browser, enter the following URL:

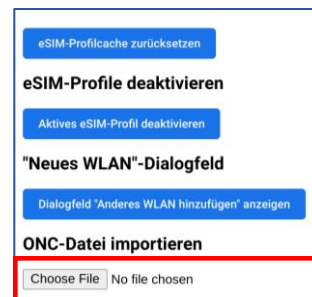
<chrome://network/#general>

1. Scroll down to “Import ONC file”
2. Click on “Choose File”
3. Import the previously downloaded file:

“eduroam-chromeos-Universitat_Hamburg-uhh.eduroam2023”



Don't delete the downloaded „ONC” file !

5.

1. Click on Wi-Fi and connect to “eduroam”



2. Configure the network as follows and click on connect:

EAP-Methode:	EAP-TTLS
EAP-Phase-2-Authentifizierung:	PAP
CA-Serverzertifikat:	Universität Hamburg Internal CA
Identity:	Stine-ID@uni-hamburg.de
Password:	Password for your Stine-ID /User-ID
Anonymous Identity	anonymous@uni-hamburg.de

Stine-ID = User-ID
e.g.: BBF1234@uni-hamburg.de
